VIEWS BOUTIQUE HOTEL & SPA

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The Mantis Group has added another superb venue to its portfolio of five-star retreats and game reserves across Africa and Europe – Views Boutique Hotel & Spa on Wilderness Beach along the famous Garden Route.



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Renowned architect Harry Burger designed Views Boutique Hotel & Spa to maximise its breathtaking setting on the Indian Ocean, where the sapphire surf and blood red sunsets are of unequalled beauty. The result is a building that boasts a magnificent view from every angle.

Inside, chic, contemporary interiors by Lulu Ridgway are styled for comfort and luxury with clean-lined, smart furnishings designed and made exclusively for Views. Water and light are themes that play throughout, from custom-made lighting systems to a three-storey rotating aquarium that showcases handcrafted glass fish and life-sized glass seagull sculptures suspended in the Sea View lounge.

Guests are invited to relax on the rooftop cocktail deck overlooking the beach and sea. Here, alfresco meals can be enjoyed, or guests can simply relax with a book and look out for whales and dolphins. Behind the cocktail deck lies the pool deck with its solar-heated flow pool that is reserved exclusively for hotel guests.

There are two restaurants on the property – Foam is a fine dining restaurant and is where guests are served breakfast, while Sails is more casual with terraced decking spilling outside for uninterrupted sea views and sunsets. Two guest lounges, Sea View and Library Lounge, offer spacious areas for relaxation.

All rooms are equipped with large LCD TV screens and are wired for iPod connection. There are 18 suites including



a Penthouse, five Honeymoon Suites, seven Premier Suites, two luxury Boutique Suites, and three deluxe suites. All rooms can be combined with a classic room to form two-bedroom suites. All rooms have floor-to-ceiling windows to maximise natural sunlight and make the most of the coastal surroundings.

Bathrooms have under-floor heating, a separate bath and shower, double basin vanities, plantation-style privacy shutters and Moya amenities.

The spa boasts four treatments rooms, including two for couples. There is also a herbal sauna and floatation room and a Rasul (a Moroccan-style chamber with a sensul shower). Guests have complimentary use of the herbal sauna, the vitality pool and the Gym which is equipped with a range of cardiovascular equipment including treadmills, cycles, an elliptical cross-trainer, vibration plates and a hydraulic strength circuit.

The hotel offers guests a variety of services including welcome drinks on arrival, 24-hour room service, movies on demand in the suites or in the surround

sound media room. Complimentary Wi-Fi access is available throughout the property.

There is currently a PRE-WORLD CUP SPECIAL valid for bookings until 10 June 2010 in Penthouse, Honeymoon and Premier Suites when one books 4 days and pays for 3 (1 night free) and a LONG STAY SPECIAL valid for bookings until 15 December 2010 in Penthouse, Honeymoon and Premier Suites when one books for 7 days and pays for 5 (2 nights free).

Rates include accommodation, full breakfast, use of the fitness centre, sauna and vitality pool, and 14% VAT and tourism levy.

The hotel is a 25-minute drive from George Airport, which offers regular connecting flights to and from Cape Town, Johannesburg and Durban.
